



COVID Precautions/Procedures

The CDC and state COVID-19 recommendations are constantly changing, so related procedures remain fluid at this time. As a result, the following are the enhanced precautions we currently have in place, but they are subject to change.

1. We are instituting a curbside drop off and pick up at the back side of the 55 Main Street building for those of you who are comfortable with it. To find, put 7 Penstock Way in your navigation system and proceed to the outside signs that includes "The Art Room." If you require further clarification and directions, let us know. As long as you are waiting during the session in your car you can pull into a 15 minute spot or just pull over to the side, you don't have to worry about being ticketed or towed. If, during scheduled sessions, you would be more comfortable pulling up to the Main Street or Municipal parking behind Aroma Joes, just be aware of time so you can return to the drop off/pick up site in a timely fashion. Also, please give us your cell phone number so that we can contact you in the unlikely event of an emergency.
2. We are scheduling appointments 15 minutes apart to allow time to disinfect all surfaces. It is especially important for you to be prompt upon both arrival and departure to allow us the time to clean and prepare for the next session. No parents are to enter the building unless previously arranged, and we are asking you to wear a mask during all face to face interactions with us.
3. We will wear a face mask and/or face shield at all times as long as the CDC recommends to do so. Children are encouraged to wear a face mask if and as much as possible. We understand that for some, this is just not possible. Parents and siblings modeling use of a mask and practicing at home may make it easier.
4. Hand sanitizer will be made readily available, and will be utilized by us and all clients at the beginning of session, throughout session, and at the end of session. If you have a preference of hand sanitizer you are certainly welcome to bring your own as long as it contains 70% isopropyl alcohol, which is the current CDC recommendation.
5. I am asking you to notify me prior to your scheduled appointment if:
 - Anyone in your household is demonstrating symptoms of any illness, including but not limited to fever (without medication) or respiratory symptoms, such as cough or shortness of breath.
 - If anyone has been directly exposed to COVID-19
 - If anyone in the house has been diagnosed with COVID-19
